## The Dallas Opera Presents Two FREE Holiday Community Concerts at Cathedral Guadalupe

### Featuring Soprano Hye Jung Lee and Tenor Matthew White Saturday, December 16 at 4:00 and 8:00 pm

(DALLAS, November 15, 2023)—The Dallas Opera is pleased to partner again with Cathedral Guadalupe in announcing two free annual Holiday Community Concerts, on **Saturday, December 16 at 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.**

Soprano Hye Jung Lee—praised by *The New York Times* for her “sweet and focused” voice—and tenor Matthew White—winner of the Deborah Voigt International Vocal Competition—join members of The Dallas Opera Orchestra at the iconic Cathedral Guadalupe (2215 Ross Ave., Dallas, TX, 75201) in downtown Dallas for these performances of holiday favorites.

The performance will be approximately one hour with no intermission, and programs in both English and Spanish will be available.

These concerts mark the second year of partnership between The Dallas Opera and the Cathedral. Registration for free tickets will begin on November 24, 2023, at [dallasopera.org/guadalupe](https://dallasopera.org/guadalupe) and remain available online through day-of-show until 2:00 pm, based on availability. Doors open 30 minutes prior to performance time; seating is first-come, first-served. Walk-ups are welcome, though seating may be limited due to capacity restrictions. Free parking is available at [Hall Arts Parking](#) located underneath the Cathedral Guadalupe. There are entrances on Ross Avenue, Pearl Street, and Crockett Street. Simply show your event ticket to the attendant.
