**August 25: *La traviata***  
**(performed live and recorded in October 2024)**

The deck is stacked against Violetta, the ill-fated heroine of this well-loved tragedy. Chilean soprano Yaritza Véliz stars as Violetta, and acclaimed Mexican tenor Javier Camarena sings the lovesick Alfredo. Iván López Reynoso guest conducts. Learn more [here](#).

**September 8: *Pelleas and Melisande* (performed live and recorded in November 2024)**

This timeless tale of forbidden love, family jealousy, and regret is set to Debussy's luminous orchestrations. Ludovic Morlot guest conducts baritone Edward Nelson (Pelleas), soprano Lauren Snouffer (Melisande), and baritone Nicolas Courjal (Golaud). Learn more [here](#).

**September 22: *Orpheus and Eurydice* (performed live and recorded in February 2025)**

In this classic Greek myth, Music Director Emmanuel Villaume conducts Gluck's gorgeous score. Leading the cast are countertenor Hugh Cutting, in his U.S. debut as the steadfast Orpheus, and soprano Madison Leonard as Eurydice. Learn more [here](#).
